GROUND IMPROVEMENTS

The new patio area in front of the pavilion is proving to be a success amongst our spectators and we just need some more sunshine to enjoy it even more. The club has invested in a self-propelled rotary mower to access the areas near to the hedges to help reduce the time taken currently to strim. Anyone able to help with this will be most welcome. The weed & feed programme was completed on our outfield recently and in time this should help improve the playing surface. Our next phase of improvements will be to replace the roof and doors to the garage to not only make it waterproof but also more secure. We have also successfully applied for a grant via the ECB Small Grant Scheme to replace our existing sheet covers which leak in several places.
